Raison d'etre and Mission of American Korean Businessmen Friendship Forum **AKBFF**

Mission Statement

In 2022 United States and Republic of Korea celebrated the 140th anniversary of diplomatic ties and in 2023 the 70th anniversary of the Korea-US Mutual Defense Treaty. The relationship between the two countries has become closer and stronger now than ever. The relationship has grown to bind the two countries with inseparable ties, which is unprecedented in the history of relationships between any two countries. Cooperation between Korea and the US in bilateral and multi-lateral trade is noteworthy and remarkable. As you are aware, Korea used to be one of the poorest countries in the world and went through a horrible internecine war. However, because of diligence and hard work of its people, Korea has now joined the economically developed countries and is enjoying the fruit of its prosperity.

With this background there is a growing need to further strengthen this good and strong economic relationship by informing the future generations of both countries of these strong ties and encourage them to maintain the tradition even more. It is essential that the governments as well as the businessmen, who have contributed greatly to the economic development of the two countries, participate in this task to promote mutual friendship and to make efforts to find a way for industrial coexistence and co-prosperity in the rapidly changing global economic environment

One noteworthy fact in this relationship is that exchanges and fellowship flow naturally among big companies and their leaders. But that is not the case for small and medium-sized businesses. The time is ripe to form an organization that would promote exchange and friendship of small and medium-sized businesses and their leaders between the two countries. Considering that Korean American Businessmen Friendship Forum (KABFF) was established already and actively working in Korea for this purpose, it is desirable to establish a US counterpart to the Korean organization.

In February of this year six businessmen and professionals got together in this area to form a preparatory committee for establishing AKBFF with the focus on business and industry leaders in small and medium-sized businesses who would sympathize with and promote together the mission and purpose of AKBFF. In the process of forming an organization with such a specific mission we determined that it would be best to establish it in the Washington, D.C. area.

Our mission is simple: Develop and Promote Friendship and Fellowship between small and medium-sized businesses of the United States and Republic of Korea. We hope AKBFF, in doing its mission, will become an essential and important bridge to the businesses of these two countries and contribute to their ever-stronger economic ties and relationship. 





Jang-HeeYoo (유장희) Senior Executive Advisor of KABFF

Dr. Yoo is a former vice president and currently a professor emeritus of EwhaWomans University. He is also serving National Academy of Sciences of Korea as Chairman, Economic & Management Division of the Academy. He taught economics at Clark University (Massachusetts) and Virginia Commonwealth University in the U.S. and Seoul National University in Korea before he joined EwhaWomans University.

He served the Korean government in various capacities, e.g., President of Korean Institute for International Economic Policy (KIEP), one of the major government thinktanks, Vice Chairman of National Economic Advisory Council for President, Chairman of Korean Commission for Corporate Partnership (KCCP) and Chairman of Policy Advisory Council for Ministry of Foreign Affairs. While he was teaching at various universities, he undertook the presidential position of major academic societies, e.g., Korean Economic Association, Korean International Economic Association, Korean Association for Negotiation Studies, and APEC Studies Association of Korea. As an economist, he worked with many private firms such as POSCO (Chairman of the Board), KT&G, Hansol Paper, and Iljin Corporation as an external director. Dr. Yoo is well known in the Korean voluntary society as well. He worked for Rotary International as the governor of its district 3650 during 2020 ~ 2021.

He graduated from Seoul National University (BA in economics), UCLA (MA in economics), and Texas A&M University (Ph.D. in economics).



Silvia Patton (윤영실) Chairwoman of the Board AKBFF

Silvia Patton is well known for her dedication to the welfare of women in need. She has been serving the local community for over 30 years in various fields such as social welfare, politics, and promoting exchange and understanding between the two countries.

Currently, she is serving as the Chairwoman of the Korean American Women's Associations of the USA, Inc. and the Advisory Council Member of National Peaceful Unification Advisory Council - Washington Chapter, and the former President of the Korean American Democratic National Organization and the BOD of Coalition of Asian Pacific Americans of Virginia and the Commissioner of Fairfax County Commission for Women, and a former member of the Virginia Asian Advisory Board to the Governor.

Ms. Patton possesses a broad spectrum of abilities including experience as an advisor, president, and superb leader.

Ms. Patton has been the recipient of many awards recognizing her ability and dedication to the community. These include the Korea Overseas Foundation Newspaper People of the Year Award, Community Service Awards from Fairfax County, Prince George County, State of Virginia and State of Maryland, the Outstanding Community Leadership Award from the Asian Pacific American Heritage Council, the Act Caring Award from the National Association of Counties. Virginia Governor's Appreciation Award, Certificates of special congressional Recognition, U.S. Senator Citation and various achievement and appreciation awards from the Korean-American Community.





Sunshik Min (민선식) President of the Korean American Businessmen's Friendship Forum

Sunshik Min is the CEO/Chairman of YBM. The company and its subsidiaries publish books and magazines, including the Korean edition of National Geographic Magazine, and administer language-proficiency and IT-skills tests. They also operate language schools for children and adults. Dr. Min is the head of the Korea International School (KIS). Founded in 2000, KIS offers a K-12 English-medium curriculum at three campuses and is fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) in the United States.

Dr. Min is actively involved in activities of not-for-profit organizations including the Korean American Businessmen's Friendship Forum (KABFF), Harvard University, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and the Korea Britain Society. He received the Medal of Industrial Merit from the Korean government and was appointed an Officer of the Order of the British Empire (OBE).

Dr. Min received a Bachelor's degree in Economics from Seoul National University, a Master's degree in Management from MIT, and a Doctoral degree in Business Administration from Harvard University. Dr. Min has served as a lecturer and adjunct professor at several universities in Korea, Singapore, and Japan.



Sangkuen Park (박상근) President of AKBFF Attorney at Law

Sang K. Park is a graduate of Seoul National University College of Law (1979) and its law school with LL.M. in International Law (1981). Came to US in 1981 and graduated from George Washington University, National Law Center with LL. M. in Comparative Law (1983) and International Law (1985). Having been a member of District of Columbia (1988), Virginia (1989) and Maryland State Bars (1992), his primary practice is in the area of commercial real estate transactions, landlord and tenant law, labor law, immigration law and conflicts of law between US and Korea. He has been associated with several title insurance companies as a transactional attorney for the past fifteen years. In helping Korean community to be assimilated into mainstream society, he served for fifteen years as a legal counsel for Korean American Association of Washington Metropolitan Area and for Korean American Grocers' Association of Greater Washington. As an advocate for political and social empowerment of Korean Americans he was one of the founders of Advocates for the Rights of Korean Americans, an advocacy organization supported by 1st and 2nd generation Korean immigrants, and later served as its executive director. In public arena, Mr. Park served as a member of Advisory Committee to Immigrant and Refugee Policy Council under Virginia General Assembly and was a member of Fairfax County Human Rights Commission from 1999 to 2001. In 2018 he finished the term as the president of Korean CBMC (Connecting Business and Marketplace to Christ) of North America that represents Korean Christian businessmen and professionals in North America.

Mr. Park has been a partner of the law firm, Moon, Park & Associates located in Annandale, Virginia, since 1992.





Go Eun Kang (강고은) President of Omni Financial Risk Management

Go Eun Elaine Kang is a President of Omni Financial Risk Management Inc. the first Korean non-life insurance agent and the largest insurance company in the Korean community in Washington metro area.

As the next-generation and women's business owners, Go Eun is trying to connect the 1st generation of Koreans and the next generation, and the bridge role between the Korean community and the mainstream American society is fulfilling their social responsibilities.

She served as a member of PUAC (Peaceful Unification Advisory Council) which advises by request and makes proposals to the President of the Republic of Korea from 2017 to 2022. She served as an executive director in PUAC Washington chapter in 2021.

From 2018 to 2019, she was the senior vice president of the Korean Society of Maryland and contributed establishing an upgraded Korean American festival framework. She was awarded the Maryland Governor's Citation in 2013 and 2018 for her contribution to the harmony of local residents.

From 2016 to the present, he has been a general director of CBMC(Connecting Business & Marketplace to Christ) in North America, and is trying to practice commitment and sharing by running companies with a Christian spirit.



Jin Keun Song (송진근) President of Hansan Inc

Jin Keun Song is the founder and current CEO of three companies: Han San Inc, A & S Contract Co, and Sung Eun Management. Han San Inc is a commercial siding and roofing company. A&S is a company that deals with government contracts and jobsites. Lastly, Sung Eun Inc is a reality company. Mr. Song has been the CEO of Han San Inc since 2009, making 2023 his 14-year anniversary.

All three companies have not only stood the test if time, but thrived for many years. As the CEO, Mr. Song used his new found wealth to bless those around him. The foundations that he currently donates to include the YW Kang Foundation for the Visually Impaired, the American Wheat Mission Inc, George Mason University's Mason: Korea project, and St Jude Children's Hospital. He also donates to multiple different cancer events and disabled children foundations every year. Mr. Song is very involved with the Korean community in Newport News. He annually donates to the Korean Elderly foundations and the local Korean Schools.





Eric Lee (이양기) Senior Vice President of Hughes Network Systems

Eric Lee (이왕기) is Senior Vice President of Hughes Network Systems, located in Germantown, Maryland and is responsible for supply chain management for the entire company. Eric has a track record of delivering strong contributions to efficiency, effectiveness, and profitability with deeply committed relationships across the US, Asia, Africa, Europe, and the Middle East. Dedicated to end-to-end demand-driven supply chain management, He consistently engages customers, suppliers, and sales teams to anticipate needs, identify cycles and proactively address market volatility.

Eric is a highly respected leader, communicator, mentor, and trusted advisor within and outside the organization. 


Sojung Lim (임소정) Owner and operator of Lim's Insurance Agency
